

*Welcome and Opening Prayer

Advent Candle Lighting:

Reader One: Isaiah said that the Lord spoke to the king and said, "Ask a sign of the LORD your God; let it be deep as Sheol or high as heaven." But when the king refused, God would not be stopped. "Therefore, the Lord himself will give you a sign. Look, the young woman is with child and shall bear a son and shall name him Immanuel."

Reader Two: God wants us to know, even when we aren't sure ourselves. God wants us to experience God's presence, even when we think we can handle life on our own. God sends us signs of God's presence with us; all we need to do is keep our eyes open and look.

Reader One: "Look, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel," which means, 'God is with us." When Joseph awoke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him; he took her as his wife but had no marital relations with her until she had borne a son; and he named him Jesus."

Reader Two: We light these candles, the candle of joyous hope, of proclaimed peace, of deep everlasting joy, and today of presence that speaks of love, as a sign that no matter our circumstance, we know we are not alone.

Next Sunday's Message:

On Christmas Eve we gather to celebrate the birth with a message called "Keeping Watch." The shepherds were busy keeping watch. The sky exploded – was the end at hand? No – fear not, there is good news. The glorious choir of angels called them to watch for and they made haste and came to see the child in the manger. Then, on Christmas Day, we will hear "The Yes/And of Jesus." First and foremost, this is the day when the distance between heaven and earth was removed and God set up camp among us; God moved into the neighborhood or "tented among us," which is what the Gospel of John says (John 1:14 – lived among us literally is tented in our midst). It is about the closeness of the living presence of God, incarnate in the one we call Jesus.
