Next Sunday's Message:

"Have the Same Mind" - In our Epistle reading, Paul says, "Have the same mind." He then implores the church to "be united in the same mind and the same purpose." This is difficult because it seems that differences are inevitable when dealing with human beings. Paul calls them, and us, "brothers and sisters." He says we are connected, we are united, and we are the family that was created not by blood, but by the life and witness and death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Yes, there are ways we will go about making our arguments and thoughts known; there are behaviors that we cannot accept as we seek reconciliation and new understandings. And in a way, Paul is asking us to consider how our inner squabbles look to the wider world. The call to watch how we live out our faith is clear. We must live in grace always.
