Next Sunday's Message: "Hidden and Mixed In" - We prefer the obvious. We like to be sure. Yet faith is something else. Our gospel text is about what is hidden in plain sight — like those car keys you can't find even though you've walked past them a half dozen times. Using a series of short parables, Jesus invites us to see the ordinary and the spectacular all together. The invitation is to stretch and reach and to get outside of ourselves so that we can see the wonder of the universe in a tiny seed. In Jacob's story we find our usual human struggles. And in the midst of these we are reminded that God brings hope even to these struggles, into that which is hidden and mixed into the ordinary stuff of life.
