Next Sunday's Message: "Scoffers on a Hill" - As we come to "reign of Christ" Sunday, we go to the cross. How could the reign of Christ begin with his death on a cross in a dump? In those around him on the cross, we see ourselves – scoffers, proof-seekers, skeptics. To these – no, for these – Jesus asks God to forgive. Jesus could have given up on humanity, rescuing himself as the scoffers were asking him to do. But, no, Jesus stayed and died, still working to make us right again with God. And he gave us an example of that too – through the thief on the cross who recognized him as Lord and Savior. Through newfound faith, this man experienced paradise then and there with Jesus. We too are invited to this same experience through our relationship with Jesus.
