March 8th – What would YOU suggest?? A crafting project... A painting effort... Something else??!!

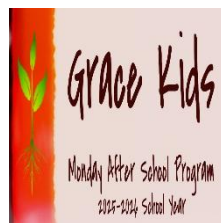

Service Saturdays — On the third Saturday of each month folks from the church gather to serve for about 3 hours. On January 17th we will _____. Ideas?????

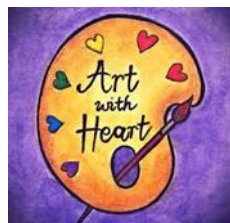
Grace Kids

On PVCC Verse of the Day, I will be posting mostly from the Upper Room Disciplines readings. Monday-Friday I will post the verse and Scripture reference and some thoughts/questions triggered by the daily devotion. If you want you can buy the book through The Upper Room, and you can also access the daily readings through their website (www.upperroom.org).

I also picked up an older devotional book by Joni Eareckson Tada: Pearls of Great Price (Zondervan 2006). It must have been leap year, because there are 366 readings. Here is an excerpt from the introduction:

"Dad Tada explained how a pearl is produced. A tiny bit of sand lodges in the flesh of an oyster and becomes an irritating intrusion. Unable to expel it, the oyster covers the particle with layer after layer of a milky secretion until the irritation has become smooth, round, and acceptable. It also, inadvertently, becomes a precious gem.... Pearls are produced by a life that has overcome affliction, that has overcome suffering.... Jesus is the Pearl of Great Price. He is unlike any other...our example" (Joni Eareckson Tada, Pearls of Great Price, 2006, Zondervan, Grand Rapids, MI, "Before You Begin").

Changes are coming. At the end of April, we will continue Livestreaming Worship on Facebook and the Grace United Facebook page will remain active, but PVCC will no longer be a part of our online presence. But Jesus, our Savior and our Pearl, is always at the Head of our Table of Grace. Whether you follow the Bible Verse of the Day on PVCC or use your own system, I hope you will develop a habit of daily reading, meditating, and prayer.
