<u>Next Sunday's Message</u>: "Give Me Water" - We're thirsty this week - thirsting for the living waters that Jesus spoke about to the woman at the well. Water is essential to life itself. Droughts scare us. The Israelites quarreled with Moses and said, "Give us water to drink!" They issued an ultimatum: "Give us water or get out!" But God says to Moses, "I will stand before you." God will provide. In our New Testament passage, Jesus comes across all the barriers. He meets us in a shared need. Jesus never seems to need a lot of response. We don't have to understand completely.
