Next Sunday's Message:

"Not Lacking" - Paul's letter to the Corinthians is to a group of Christians who considered themselves better than the average believer. Paul reminds them that they were "called to be saints." For Paul, though, the word 'saint' meant someone who recognized their need for a savior. So Paul was asking them to examine their behavior to see if they still fit that definition. He also wanted to remind the Corinthians that they were part of something larger than themselves. In this way we too are invited to look within as we too are reminded that we are called to be saints. Join us next Sunday as we learn of our need for a savior, as we learn to be the church, and as we learn to live as the saints that we are called to be.
