Next Sunday's Message: "Is It Fair?" - We claim to want fairness. Or at least fairness in our favor. But deep down, we do not want fairness but mercy. At least that is what we want from God. Joseph goes from the pit to second in command in all of Egypt. This was a hard road – one lacking in fairness but steeped in mercy. Along the way Joseph learned not to ask "Why me?" but "What does the Lord require of me now?" Life wasn't always fair, but God could be trusted. The Canaanite woman who comes to Jesus had lived more than her share of unfair. She has been overlooked and marginalized and abused. She has learned to persevere. Although Jesus is less than receptive, she is willing to take crumbs – that means she and her child can live a bit longer. Her faith leads Jesus to commend her. She did not come seeking fairness. She sought mercy.
