Next Sunday's Message: "Entitlement" - The scene is a wedding banquet – of the king's son, no less. This parable about heaven has a twist. The invited guests do not come. Worse yet, they abuse the messengers sent to invite them. So the king welcomes the un-welcomeable. Yet today, the good news is still meant for the hungry. We can forget that. When we lose sight of the radical grace inherent in the invitation to Christ, we have forgotten both who we are and how we got here. There we can get caught up in what we deserve. And there we are incapable of seeing God's blessing and of expressing our gratitude. The proper response to the king's invitation is this: to drop everything and run breathless to the banquet, wondering how we ever were invited in the first place.
